


# Welcome & Methodology

Welcome to the Top 100 Vertical Market MSPs<sup>™</sup> 2019 Edition. The research and corresponding list are based on a ChannelE2E<sup>™</sup> editorial coverage and worldwide survey of MSPs, conducted in Q4 2018 through January 2019. Rankings are based on annual recurring revenues in specific vertical markets. This is our fourth-annual research report.



**Participating MSPs: Focus Areas\*** 


#### **Combined Vertical Market Recurring Revenues\***



◆ This year's results saw a significant increase in the financial services vertical (up from 16% last year) and a minor increase in the notfor-profit vertical (up from 3% last year). The healthcare vertical fell a bit (from 26% last year) amid continued M&A in that sector. The "Other" category was essentially flat with last year as numerous niches (such as media and transportation) continue to attract MSPs.

### UPSIDE

The top seven digital transformation trends in financial services for 2019 include mobile banking, mobile pay, mobile apps (particularly third-party services that integrate with banking apps), blockchain, automated wealth management, and back-end systems automation to eliminate paper-based loan applications and more, according to BroadSuite Media Group.

#### DOWNSIDE

Banks, obviously, remain direct and indirect targets for hackers. Phishing attacks, payroll scams and other digital heists have hit multiple banks and their end-customers in early 2019. Recent victims include the City of Tallahassee, Florida, which suffered a \$500,000 hack involving its bank and payroll system. Banks may also face more competition as Apple, Amazon and other technology giants seek to ease or disrupt the credit and lending markets.

#### UPSIDE

Digital health tools have been riding the peak of the hype cycle for several years now, but 2019 will be the year that digital health innovators will be accountable for delivering tangible results, according to HIMSS (the Healthcare Information and Management Systems Society). MSPs will need to push hard into artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning to help providers identify at-risk customers who have emerging or hidden health issues, HIMSS says. Also, expect broader use of voice recognition, chatbots and intelligent assistants to reduce clinician burden, HIMSS says.

#### DOWNSIDE

MSPs are generally late to the AI and machine learning market. Also, HIPAA compliance discussions and privacy discussions remain timely. However, MSPs sometimes underestimate how much time and knowledge are required to monetize such discussions.

According to the Association of Equipment manufacturers, the top five trends in this vertical for 2019 include: Intelligent manufacturing, data utilization, IoT sensors on manufacturing floors, workforce training (and retraining), and artificial intelligence for robotics.

#### DOWNSIDE

As we've pointed out before, the typical MSP lacks expertise in the big growth areas like AI, robots and big data analysis from IoT sensors -- all of which will be piloted in 2019 with broad adoption by 2021, according to IQMS.

The game plan for MSPs in the not-for-profit vertical is relatively straightforward. As outlined by DNL MNI Media: First, understand the not-for-profit's annual fundraising goals for the current year, and how it compares to the previous year. Second, determine which fundraising tools are already in place and measure their effectiveness -paying close attention to online giving and mobile giving. Third, assist a data strategy that helps organizations grow their donor base. Fourth, figure out an IT budget that aligns with those goals.

#### DOWNSIDE

MSPs may face a chicken-and-the-egg quandary, since not-for-profits sometimes have trouble finding budget for their fundraising activities. Still, the shift toward SaaS-based services has, in many cases, lowered the upfront cost burden.

#### **GOVERNMENT UPSIDE**

The proposed 2020 federal IT spending budget is roughly \$88 billion — or roughly flat with previous budgets. Much of the focus involves cybersecurity, cloud-first transitions away from on-premises data centers, and self-service applications that allow U.S. citizens to more easily interact with the government. At the state and local level, North Dakota is the first state to promote a single cybersecurity plan that spans all of its agencies and schools.

#### **GOVERNMENT DOWNSIDE**

In-fighting between Republicans and Democrats has delayed a much-hyped plan to strengthen physical and digital infrastructure -- such as highways, bridges, airports, railroads and associated IT systems.

#### **EDUCATION UPSIDE**

Lawsuits and ethical questions are forcing universities and colleges to rethink how they recruit and admit students, offer financial aid and scholarships, and classify students according to race and sex. Many of those debates and shifts will require data- and application-centric upgrades.

#### **EDUCATION DOWNSIDE**

Universities, colleges and K-12 schools continue to experience heightened layoffs, a trend that we noted

in our previous two reports. Those tight budgets aren't limited to classrooms, and many colleges are re-thinking their long-term technology plans. Some universities are trying to activate SaaSbased education systems on their own, bypassing partners along the way.
